Kitchen Design Zones

Make your life easier - divide your kitchen into zones!
Speak with your Design Artist about your personal or family habits so they can create workspaces arranged in a way that suits your needs. Zones create a smooth workflow and puts everything exactly where you need it.



Smooth Flow Workspaces™

When planning a kitchen, it is important to consider daily kitchen activities to make sure your kitchen is arranged in a way that will be easy to navigate. Specific storage items are used more

frequently than others. Store the items that are used daily closer to the countertop and seldomly used items in the top or very bottom level of cabinets.



Design Zones

Every kitchen can be divided into five kitchen zones - regardless of size or shape.



CONSUMABLES

Food is kept in the consumables zone. When planning this zone, it is important to ensure that everything is within easy reach.



NON-CONSUMABLES

The non-consumables zone is designed for cutlery, dishes, glasses, and plastic containers, which is why it is always a good idea to have the dishwasher close by.



CLEANING

This zone houses the dishwasher and sink. Cleaning utensils and cleaning agents should be kept here so that everything is close at hand.



PREPARATION

All the items needed for preparing food are kept in this zone. Drawers ensure that they are within easy reach.



COOKING

There should be enough space for pots, pans, lids, and cooking utensils close to the cooktop.

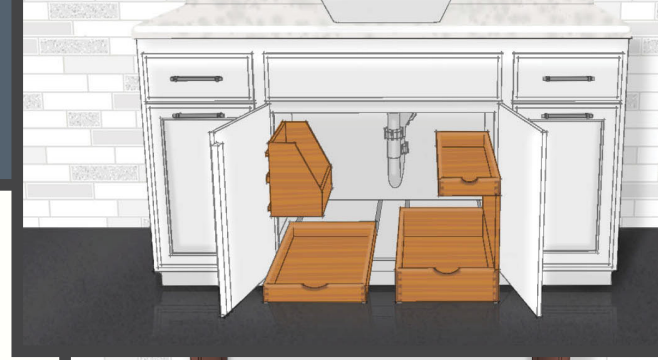

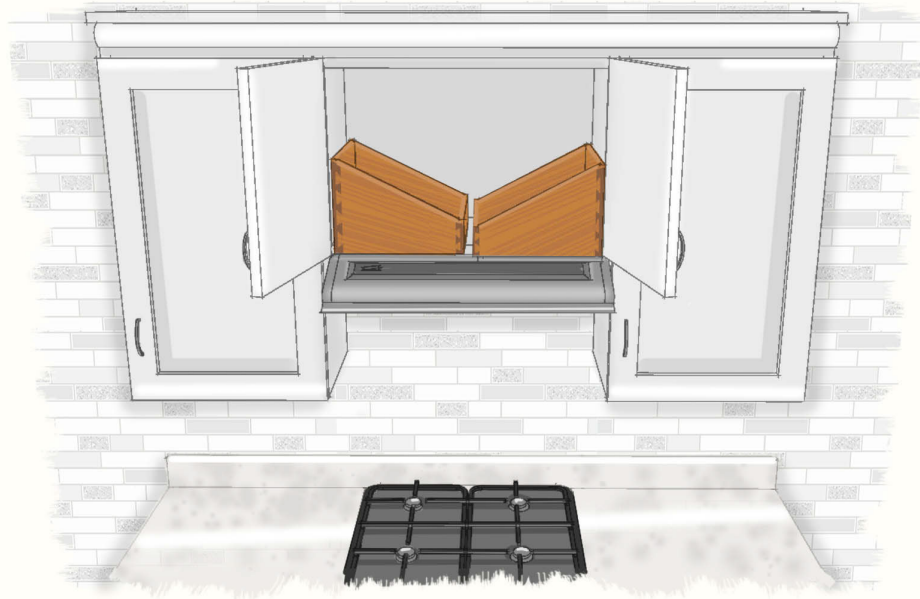

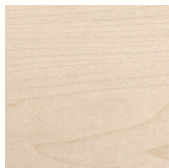
Materials

Most popular wood species



9-Ply Baltic Birch - This economical plywood is unlike plywood you may be used to seeing, with an all birch veneer core, giving it increased strength and stability.



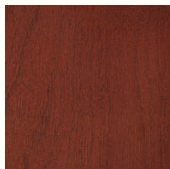
Soft Maple - This beautiful hard wood is rich, light, and features a well balanced wood grain. Its color ranges from pale brown to almost white with highlights of brown.



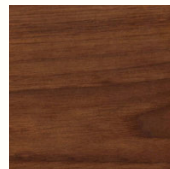
Natural Maple - Generally straight-grained with a consistent texture, maple also can have a bird's-eye or curly (also called fiddle back) pattern. Its unique color, smooth grain, and strength making natural maple a popular choice for those wanting to add extra character to their masterpiece.



Most popular wood species



Cherry - Strong and regal in color, the heartwood of cherry varies from rich red to reddish brown, and it deepens to its characteristic reddish brown with age and exposure to light. Cherry wood has a straight, satiny grain, often with a ripple figure. Heavy and hard, stiff and strong, the wood is durable and great for everyday use.



Walnut - One of the most enjoyed American hardwoods for its fine-yet-open grain, unique patterns, and bold dark color, walnut is a handsome wood. Walnut trees often bear knots and burls, that produce tightly swirling patterns full of charisma and grace.

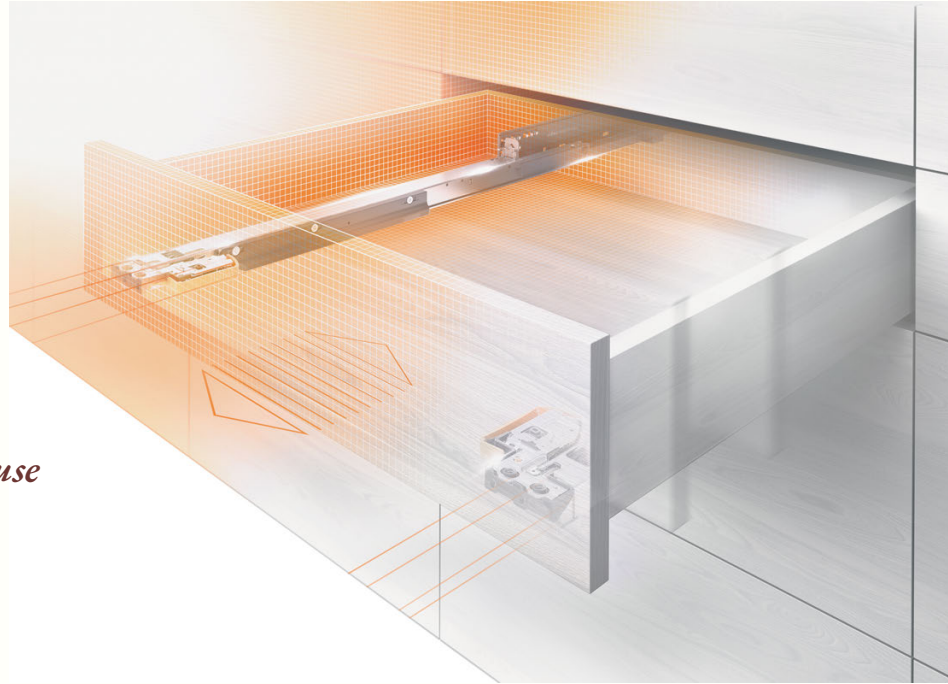

Upgrades

Slopes - Slopes offer further pull out customization. Slopes prevent tall items from tipping when stored in the back of the pull out drawer. A common location for a sloped drawer is in the upper portion of a pantry.

Scoops - Scoops provide a beautiful designer touch to your drawers. In addition, the scoop provides a handle to effortlessly pull out drawers in spaces with a small amount of height clearance.

Dividers - Don't let anything get in the way of staying organized. Our custom dividers allow you get into the groove and put everything in its place.

Slope Options

Diagonal Partial Side Taper

This box is typically used as a pullout drawer. It has a higher back that is partially tapered on each side to a lower front.



Range Box Side Scallop

This box is typically used as a cooking range drawer. It has a lower back that is scalloped up on each side to a higher front.

DOVETAILS

The dovetail is symbolic of fine woodworking.

There is simply no stronger or prettier way to join the sides of a Drawer, which will be pulled in and out thousands of times in its life. There are two parts to a dovetail joint, pins and tails. The tails look like the tails of doves (hence the name), and the pins are on the opposite board and fit in between the tails to create a joint that is impossible to pull apart.
